Fund Description

The SoFi Gig Economy ETF seeks long-term capital appreciation by providing exposure to companies involved in the revolutionary shift towards a “gig” economy—a free-market system comprised of freelancers and shared resources, such as transport and real estate.

- **Thematically-focused** - GIGE is the first ETF to concentrate specifically in this new and exciting sector and provides access to companies in the Gig Economy.
- **Globally diversified** - The Gig Economy is global, which is why approximately 40 to 50% of GIGE's holdings consist of companies outside the United States.
- **Actively managed** - Unlike passively managed ETFs, actively managed ETFs like GIGE are capable of quickly responding to changing market conditions. This includes quickly accessing hot tech IPOs (Initial Public Offerings).
- **Designed with SoFi investors in mind** - SoFi ETFs target a higher risk-return profile, suitable for long-term investors who are both beginning their investment journeys and well on their way.


